**STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINE #39**

**HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT MEMBER**

**Purpose:** That all personnel know the guidelines for members of the department who are still attending high school.

**Scope:** To provide guidance to members of the department who are still attending high school on their restrictions, obligations, and requirements.

1. Personnel shall not carry their pager during school hours or while attending after school events.
2. Personnel shall not respond to any calls after 10 pm the night before a school day. Personnel can respond at any time after the conclusion of the last scheduled day of the school year until 10 pm the day before school resumes.
3. Personnel are not allowed to install emergency lights or sirens on their vehicle until they have graduated from high school and are a licensed Medical First Responder or Certified Firefighter.
4. Personnel shall not respond to any call with any other occupants in their vehicle.
5. Personnel shall notify the Fire Chief of any changes to their driving record.
6. Personnel that are on suspension from high school will be suspended from the department pending an explanation to the department officers at a scheduled officer meeting. Pertinent information will then be referred to the Burlington Township Board for determination of continued employment.
7. Personnel must maintain passing grades in all classes to remain on the department.
8. The Fire Chief may update or revise these rules at any time.
